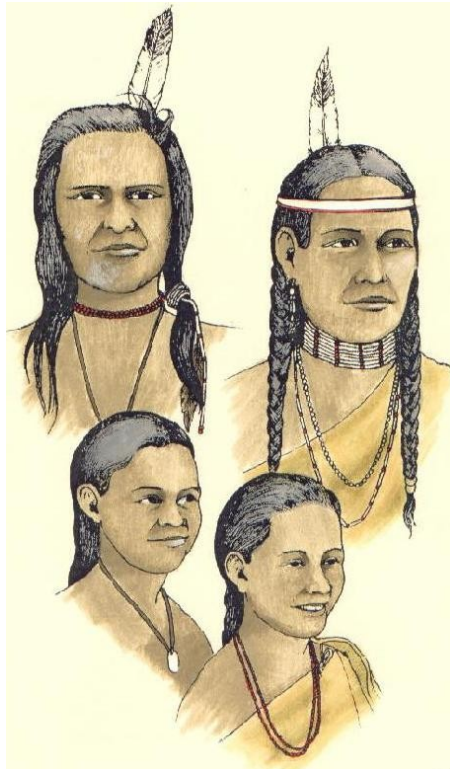
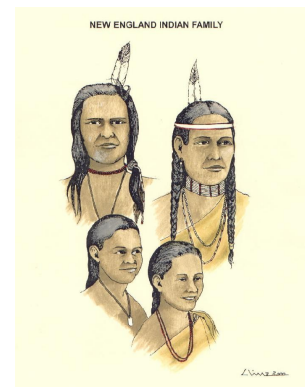


The Wampanoag





American Indians were the first people to live in the United States. They are members of special groups called tribes. The Wampanoag was a tribe located in the northeastern United States. Each tribe lived in different ways. The Wampanoag were the tribe that helped the Pilgrims.





The Wampanoag lived in the eastern part of the United

States. They lived in homes called wigwams.

These homes were made by bending and tying

together long poles that were cut from small

trees. The poles made a frame that woven mats

were then tied to. The mats were made out of

tree branches that were woven together. Often

tree bark was used with the mats to create the

walls of the wigwam. A hole was left at the top

of the home to allow smoke from cooking fires to

escape.
